Please keep in mind that the district is using the following guidelines for returning to school after an illness.

- If your child has a fever of 100.0 F or more, they may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours **without** the use of fever reducing medications like Tylenol
- If your child was vomiting, they may return to school after they have gone 48 hours without vomiting
- If your child was experiencing diarrhea, they may return to school after having gone 48 hours without any episodes of diarrhea
- If your child tested positive for Covid, please refer to Outagamie Public Health for recommendations for positive cases
 - Stay home for 5 days after symptoms began. If your student does not have symptoms, test day is Day 0, AND
 - Return to school after being fever free for 24 hours **without** the use of fever reducing medications
- For Covid-like symptoms, Influenza symptoms, or generally not feeling well:
 - Stay home
 - Return to school after 24 hours fever-free without fever reducing medications
 - Return to school after 48 hours without vomiting or diarrhea
- Rashes or patches of broken, itchy skin need to be examined by a healthcare provider if they appear to be spreading or not improving
- Also note that for an absence to not count against your student, we need to have a note from a provider stating they cannot be at school and/or were seen in the clinic
